This brochure, which is produced by the Town of Camillus, lists many of the offerings available to all the residents of both the town and the village. There are some services that the village offers that differ from the town as follows:

Highway Department – The Village DPW operates separately from the town in that we own our own garbage truck and pick up garbage on Monday and Tuesday and recyclables on Wednesday. On Thursday and Friday, we will pick up other items such as yard waste, household materials, small amounts of construction material and other items you may deem as junk. There is no additional charge for this service. There is a \$20 mattress removal fee which must be paid in advance with cash or check. You can call the office @ 315-672-3484 and make arrangements to pay this fee prior to pick up. If you have excessive amounts of trash/junk, you can call the Village Hall for fee details and to pre-arrange to rent one of our trucks to be left at your residence overnight for you to load. We do not allow any junk/trash from other areas to be brought in to be picked up by our crew.

The Village DPW maintains the village roads, including snowplowing, and plows our business district sidewalks.

Code Enforcement – The Village Code Enforcement is overseen by Mr. Bill Reagan. If you need to contact Mr. Reagan, please call the village office at 315-672-3484.

Village Hall - The Village Hall hours are Monday through Friday – 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. You can reach Sharon Norcross, Clerk/Treasurer and Carrie Grooms, Deputy Clerk at 315-672-3484. The Village Hall is located at 37 Main Street (across from Camillus Mills). Holiday closings are the same as listed for the town.

The Village meetings for 2023 are as follows and open to the public. Meetings occur on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month with some exceptions. The meetings start @ 6:00 PM. The dates for 2023 are as follows:

**Services:**

Work Calendar- The work calendar is posted on the highway website to inform you where our highway crews may be working. This will help you keep track of ongoing work efforts like fall leaf pick up or summer paving and drainage repairs.

Road Maintenance- Maintenance of the roadway system includes periodic paving and repair of the roadway system, snow and ice removal, sweeping and removal of street litter, implementation and maintenance of roadway signage, maintenance of roadside sidewalks.

Drainage System Maintenance- Closed drainage system, roadside gutter system, stormwater detention/retention, open swales and drainage ways, green infrastructure.

Brush and Leaf Pickup- The Highway Department picks up residential brush and leaves and operates a composting facility at the Highway Department. Leaves and brush are picked up on a rotating schedule during the months of April through October. (November through March as weather permits) You may drop off yard waste at the Highway Department and compost may be picked up free of charge during business hours.

Metal Disposal- Recyclable metals may be dropped off at the Highway Department or larger items may be picked up by the department (by appointment only).

Recycling Bins- You may visit the OCRRA site on Airport Road for a replacement blue recycling bin during their working hours. Large bins on wheels are supplied by your trash hauler.

Liquid Containers, Paint/Paint Cans, Television Sets,
Refrigerators, other Electronic devices, Upholstered Furniture,
Mattresses

Last Load will be taken 15 minutes before close.

ALL Customers MUST be off site by closing. Please plan accordingly.

Construction and Demolition Fees-

Trucks are weighed upon entry and exit and are billed by the ton. See the Town Landfill website for current rates.

CAMILLUS MUNICIPAL DOG CONTROL

I would like to take this opportunity to ask dog owners to be mindful of your dog's behavior and how that behavior may affect other community neighbors such as: keeping the barking from your dog controlled so it does not disturb others. While walking your dog, refrain from allowing your dog to stray onto private property, urinate on mailboxes, flowers, or shrubs as it can be damaging. If your dog needs to defecate, please be prepared with a bag to pick the waste up and take it with you for a proper disposal. Don't approach dogs unless you know the dog very well and don't let strangers approach your dog, even good dogs bite when uncomfortable or startled. Thank you!

REMINDER: The Town of Camillus has two dog friendly parks, Camillus Park and the Erie Canal Trail Park. All other Town parks do not allow dogs in them. As required by law, dogs must be leashed at all times, and their feces must be picked up and disposed of properly by the person walking that dog. This ensures safety for you and your dog and allows others to enjoy these parks.

DOG LICENSING: Required by New York State and Town law, all dogs over four months of age must be licensed. Licenses are issued by the Town Clerk's office and proof of a current rabies vaccination and proof of spay/neuter, (if it has been done) must be supplied. In Camillus, the fee is \$7 if spayed/neutered; \$14 if not.

MISSING OR FOUND DOGS: If your dog is missing, or if you have found a dog, contact the Dog Control Office immediately to report it. The goal of the Dog Control Office is to get the stray dogs we pick up back to their owner safely and promptly.

ENHANCED AND BASIC STAR

New Applicants- Apply for STAR CREDIT directly with New York State either online at <https://www.tax.ny.gov/pit/property/star/> or call (518)457-2036 to register.

* This is now a CREDIT, not an exemption.

EXISTING Basic STAR exemptions - If turning 65 before December 31st, call office between 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily for instructions, prior to March 1st.

Existing Enhanced STAR Exemptions- No renewal necessary

During this time of uncertainty, Onondaga County's Department of Water Environment Protection (WEP) continues to stand ready to provide essential and critical sewer service to the 21 municipalities within the County's Consolidated Sanitary District. In response to ongoing developments relating to the (COVID-19) pandemic, WEP has enacted interim protocols to keep our staff and the public safe and ensure uninterrupted wastewater services to the more than 140,000 customers in the CSD. The information below explains how we have adapted the way we do business during this time.

1. Plumbing Control: Plumbing control provides a critical public health service for Onondaga County residents. Its goal is to see that plumbing installations conform to local laws and public health standards to promote the safety and public health of county residents. Plumbing Control will continue to provide these services. All application materials and inspection information shall be submitted electronically to the Plumbing Control Supervisor, Dennis Miesner (dennismiesner@ongov.net). Guidance on electronic process can be found here. In the event of an Emergency, you can reach Dennis Miesner at 315-640-2005

2. Sewer Service Calls: WEP responds to more than 4,000 trouble calls and service requests from homeowners and businesses that are having trouble with their sewers every year. If you're having a sewer issue, please Call (315) 435-3157 – the number is answered 24 hours a day.

We ask that the public, (including plumbers & engineers) don't randomly stop by for any reason, without an appointment, even just to drop off paperwork. In addition, anybody granted entrance to the building is to adhere to current CDC guidelines. Masks are required to enter the building. *In order to mitigate potential exposure to our employees and customers, the Department of Water Environment Protection (WEP) will be eliminating face to face contact when performing sewer lateral service calls. Until further notice, we ask that you do not go out to speak with the field staff while they are working at your location. WEP staff will contact you by phone or by written notification of the resolution of the service lateral issue you experienced. We appreciate your cooperation and support of our efforts at social distancing!*

OCWA operates a work center on Hinsdale Road in the Town where maintenance crews are dispatched from to maintain the water system. ABOUT US

Dependable Disposal, LLC provides weekly trash and bi-weekly recycling service for the Town of Camillus. On the weeks when both trash and recycling totes are out, please leave 4' in between the totes and also leave totes 4' away from any inanimate object (i.e tree, mailbox, ditch etc). Trash and recycling service begins at 6AM, Monday-Thursday. Each household is allowed no more than (10) 30 gallon bags of trash weekly. Please bag all trash. Office hours: Monday-Friday 8AM-5PM.

WEEKLY PICK-UP ITEMS

(Please put in your trash tote)

Small chairs, crib (broken down), lamps, wood, cushions, vacuum cleaners, end tables, scrap metal (old pots, pans, mop handles, etc.) small patio furniture, shelving (3' lengths), small children's toys, latex paint (dried, lid off)

- 10 (30 gal.) bags of trash per house, per week
- 10 rolls of carpet/padding, cut in 3x3 sections

SPECIAL PICK-UP ITEMS

- Upholstered chair, table, loveseat, recliner, couch, dresser
- Large Uncut Carpet (max. 5' length)
- Each household is allowed 2 items per year at no charge
- Please contact our office to schedule a removal
- Mattress/box springs set (all sizes, 1 item, \$15 charge)

Refrigerator \$50, Freezer \$50, Air conditioner \$40,

CHEMOTHERAPY AND RADIATION

Due to NYS Health Department regulation, Dependable Disposal is not allowed to take any materials; i.e. depends, bandages, pads, or any materials containing bodily fluids from chemotherapy or radiation patients. Contact local hospitals for proper disposal information.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF USED NEEDLES AND OTHER SHARPS

Sharps is a term for medical services with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut the skin.

**Ummm...
YES!**

Immediately place used sharps in a plastic laundry detergent bottle and secure with a tight-fitting lid. Write SHARPS with a marker on top. Place SHARPS container in your trash tote on top of the trash bags.

**Ummm...
NO!**

Throw loose sharps into the trash or flush them down the toilet. They are not recyclable and do not go in the recycling bin.

PLEASE DO NOT BAG RECYCLING




