Since 2016, I have served as the 3rd Ward Councilor. This year the 3rd Ward has expanded adding District #25. This occurred because of the census that was taken. It is all population driven. To the residents living in this changed district, I welcome you to the 3rd Ward.

I look forward to assisting you and hope to meet you in the near future. If you have neighborhood associations, I would be happy to have a meet and greet. At the end of this letter, there will be my contact information. I do emails to keep everyone up to date with happenings in the Town. As Deputy Supervisor since January 2023, my duties have included involvement in pertinent issues important to the town and assisting the Supervisor.

Some updates on our facilities include a new roof on Town Hall, after repairs showed it needed replacement. Funds came from our building account that we maintain. We received a \$100,000 grant from the county to repair the Senior Citizen Center foundation. Community grants have helped the town with improvements to Shove Park, used by many of our youth groups and organizations.

We continue to apply for state and county grants to repair and improve our facilities and parks.

Currently I am part of the committee that is updating the Town Comprehensive Plan. I have been on this committee since 2005 as a Camillus Chamber board member before becoming a councilor. We are working in conjunction with Onondaga County planners. Our Town has had a Comprehensive Plan since 1997. Its concept is to be an open working plan adapting to present needs, while planning for the future. A grant is available to us to complete this project.
